What is "Maine's First Ship"?

The year 2007 will mark the 400th anniversary of Maine's Popham Colony. **Maine's First Ship**, a non-profit corporation, was formed in 1997 at Popham Beach to reconstruct the pinnacle VIRGINIA, that colony's greatest achievement, and to celebrate the proud beginning of Maine's long and honorable shipbuilding tradition.

What was the VIRGINIA?

The VIRGINIA was the first English large wooden ship known to be constructed in New England, perhaps even the first North American built vessel suited to trans-Atlantic trade. Her purpose was to assist the Popham Colony's exploration and trading efforts on our coast. When the colony was abandoned in 1608, she carried men and material back to England, then re-crossed the Atlantic in 1609 to re-supply the Jamestown colony in Virginia. She may have made other Atlantic crossings.

What will Maine's First Ship do?

Education, research, and involvement. For starters, we have invited every school system in Maine to participate in our efforts. Vessel design and research into construction methods continues on both sides of the Atlantic. VIRGINIA will be built and launched in Phippsburg some time in 2007. She will operate on the Kennebec River and sail along our coast, representing Maine's early 17th century skills and peoples, honoring our great shipbuilding heritage. *We would be honored to have you join us!*

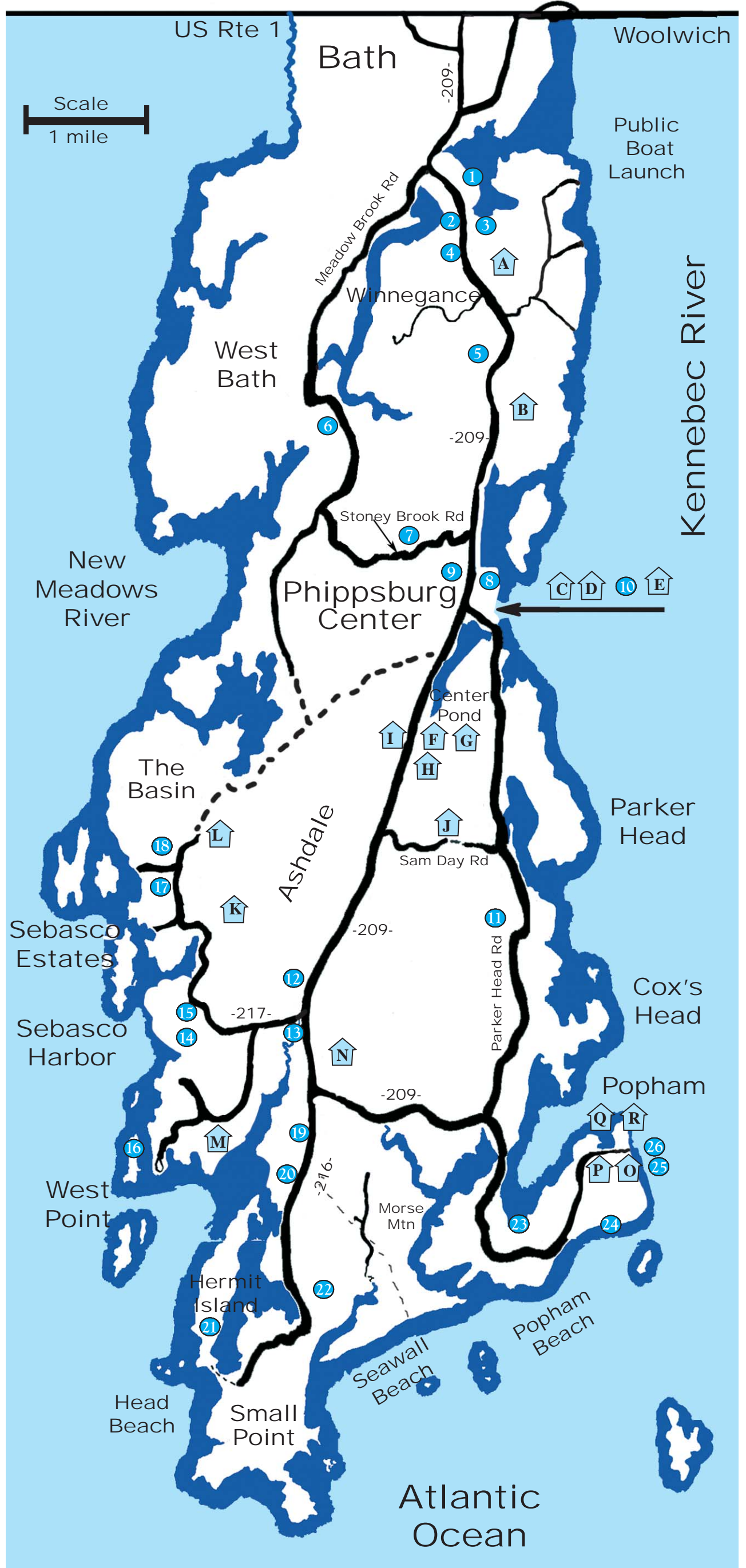
