The Phippsburg Conservation Commission is pleased to announce that the first batch of compost is ready for use. In 2014, the grass and leaf composting pilot project began as a result of the efforts of Bob Fernald to encourage the town to compost at the transfer station, as a way of reducing the material we dispose.

Just last week, Curtis turned the compost pile and it is looking good! It will get even better with time! For this year, as we try to gauge the demand for compost, we are limiting use of the compost to Phippsburg residents only for the equivalent of two garbage cans full per visit.

Thanks also to contributors for separating your leaves and grass clippings from other brush over the year and placing it in the compost area. Thoughts and suggestions welcome.
