Chair Pye declared a quorum at 6:11pm.


Chair Pye motioned to accept the minutes of the August 15th meeting, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

Public Facilities & Services: Mrs. Shiebler asked that the library be added to the list of services because of population growth. Chair Pye motioned to have Step 1. a low priority- and ongoing for police-fire-emergency-waste disposal and library, Mr. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote. Chair Pye motioned to have Step2. a low priority- and show progress within two years by the Selectmen and Budget Committee, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote. Mrs. Shiebler motioned to have Step 3. a medium priority- and to have the evaluation process done within two years by the Fire Chief and Selectmen, Mr. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote. Mr. Shiebler motioned to have Step 4. a low priority- and ongoing for the waste management responsibility of the Selectmen and other department heads as needed- no State involvement, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

Recreation & Access: Goal 1. Mrs. Shiebler motioned to have it a low priority and the Recreation Committee to provide a strategy within one year, Mr. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote. Goal 2. Mr. Shiebler motioned to have it a low priority and ongoing for the Recreation Committee to have an ice rink built within one year- perhaps at the school, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote. Mrs. Shiebler motioned to have Goal 3. a medium priority- and the Recreation Committee to have some results within a year, Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote. Mr. Shiebler motioned to have Goal 4. a low priority and ongoing for the Road Commission to continue soliciting the State for more improvements, Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote. Mr. Shiebler motioned for Goal 5. to be a low priority given to the Town Landing Committee-asking them to identify the already existing points and broadcast them on Channel 3 for the public, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote. Mr. Hatch is planning to gift land and access at Center Pond at a special Town Meeting in October. Mrs. Shiebler motioned to have Goal 6. a low priority and the Recreation Committee take on the goal and achieving it within two years and then to be submitted to the Selectmen for approval, Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote.

Next meeting- October 3rd- to talk about the October 5th meeting with Stacey Benjamin from the State, next Sections; Schools and Roads. Mr. Shiebler motioned to adjourn, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote
