Implementation Committee
Feb.6th, 2007

Present: Chair Lawrence Pye, Paul Shiebler, Connie Shiebler
Meeting opened at 5:53.

Marie Varian and Les Smith from the Land Use Committee were there to ask the Committee for help in gaining the maps from the mappers. They expressed their concern that their committee was going to come to a stand still if the new, revised maps were not provided soon. The mappers have been putting off the Towns maps- supposedly because they were to busy with other towns. The Land Use Committee requested that the Implementation Committee help move the mappers along. Mrs. Varian did not know of any contract between the town and the mappers- but the mappers have been paid for what has not been delivered. Chair Pye said he would mention it at the next Selectmen's meeting and perhaps go and meet with Judy (Spatial Alternatives-mapper). Mrs. Varian and Mr. Smith also mentioned the need for money. There is \$5000. now for the two Committees. Implementation probably won't need much unless Dr. Lea needed some. The money is available for what ever is needed. Chair Pye asked if another \$5000. would be enough to get the maps copied. Mrs. Varian said she did not know. Chair Pye said he would mention it at the Budget Committee meeting. Mrs. Varian just wanted to mention the money before there was a need for it.

Pg 17 Marine Resources (cont.)

Goal 4-1. Mr. Shiebler motioned to contact Doug Alexander, the Harbor Master, to explore the possibilities of promoting safety education within a year. Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote.

2. Mr. Shiebler motioned to have the Harbor Master explore and utilize the Town's cable TV station and web page listings for research and educational offerings. Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

Goals 5- Mr. Shiebler motioned that the Town should recognize the efforts and continues support of the Shellfish Commission- which is self funding thru fees. Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote.

Goal 6-1. Mrs. Shiebler motioned that the Conservation commission and the Harbor Commission continue to promote shared use of sanitary pump stations, Mr. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

2. Mr. Shiebler motioned that the Selectmen should explore the cable TV station as a way to inform the people of town to the 3 waste oil collection facilities and their locations. Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote.

Goal 7-1. Mrs. Shiebler motioned that the Town Landing Committee should explore current conditions and options for maintaining and installing floats and ramps at Town landings with a report of findings with in 1 ½ years. Chair Pye seconded, unanimous vote.

2. Mrs. Shiebler motioned the Town Landing Committee should access the need and availability of new landing sites and submit an annual report to the Selectmen exploring ownership of State land. Mr. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

3. Chair Pye motioned that the Harbor commission and Town Landing Committee were responsible for attaining grant monies once the need has been secured and described. Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

Pg 22 Ground Water

Overall Goal 1-5. Chair Pye motioned that the Land Use Committee be responsible for all points, with the Planning Board being included in #5 to keep it in mind. Mr. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

Pg 24 Forestry, Agriculture and Open Spaces

Key Goal

1. Chair Pye motioned that Tax Assessor, Town Administrator, and Town Clerk be involved with participation of informing the town of item 1, perhaps with pamphlets sent out with tax bills or on the Town's Cable station. Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.
2. Chair Pye motioned that the Land Use Committee should consult with the Maine Forestry Service on Best Management Practices on forestry and put in the newest addition of Ordinances, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.
3. Chair Pye motioned that the CEO, Selectmen and the Planning Board should continue to enforce the standards in the Shoreland Zone. Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.

Mr. Shiebler motioned to adjourn, Mrs. Shiebler seconded, unanimous vote.
