

“Do’s” and “Don’ts” of What To Wear During Hunting Season!

DO:

DO wear clothing so other people can SEE you from a distance!!

DO wear high visibility, Safety Orange* colored clothing – the more, the better!!
(*It’s also known as blaze orange or hunter’s orange; just any color of orange isn’t good enough!)

DO remember to protect your dogs (and horses, if riding them in the woods) with Safety Orange gear, too!
(A bandana tied around their necks, a special collar or a vest!)

DON’T:

DON’T wear white or brown colors!
(unless you really-y want to resemble a deer!)

DON’T wear camouflage gear!
You want to be SEEN, not hidden, when hiking, walking your dog, taking photos, etc.)

DON’T think just because you wear *bright* colors (orange, red, pink, etc.) that other people can see you!
(During the fall, trees and bushes also appear orange, red and brown so you’ll simply blend in.)

DON’T forget to wear an appropriate, visible hat or cap!!
(Your blonde, brown...or white/grey... hair could be easily mistaken as being on an animal’s head!)

Make it **CLEAR** you're not a deer!
