

**Phippsburg Police Department**  
**Police Officers - Part Time**

The Phippsburg Police Department is looking to fill two Part-time Patrol Officer positions for a small, community-service oriented department.

The positions require approximately 500 hours annually, including training time. The majority of those hours are worked from Memorial Day – Through Labor Day, averaging a 16-20 hour work week throughout the summer season, including evening and weekend shifts when summer tourism is the busiest.

Candidates must be 21 years old, possess a valid Maine driver's license, possess a High School Diploma or GED, have no criminal history, and pass an extensive background and psychological exam. Seeking applicants with strong communication skills.

The Town of Phippsburg will provide all uniforms, equipment and will pay for training when hired. The starting rate of pay ranges from \$15 to \$17/hour, based on experience. The Department is looking for candidates who will serve a minimum of two years.
