## MINUTES

*Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. with Selectmen Totman and Rice present*

1. Review and Sign:

- Accounts payable and payroll warrants
- Concealed Weapons Permit
- Minutes
- Emergency Plans, Hazardous Communications and Fleet Program

**All items reviewed and signed.**

2. Meetings and Hearings:

- (6:00) - Meet with Road Commissioner and West Point residents concerning (1) Wallace Circle road construction and (2) discuss DOT issues concerning Popham Rd (209)

**Meeting held. (1) The cost for repaving the section of Wallace Circle from Pete's Cculvert to Kate's Wharf (425 feet) is approximately 23,000 (\$13,062 for paving, \$1000 for catch Basin, \$1,210 for culvert, \$1,600 ledge removal, \$2,200 trench culvert, \$4,000 for local construction costs.) If Cat Cove is done it would cost an additional \$2,000.00. The decision to hold a Special Town Meeting was tabled until the next meeting. Selectmen agreed to look into parking issues after the paving is completed. (2) In order for DOT to reconstruct the section of Route 209 from the Popham/Parker Head crossroad to the Percy's they would have to purchase the right of ways because many sections are only 2 rod wide. This would add \$100,000 to \$150,000 to the project. This decision was tabled until the next meeting.**

- Meet with the Comprehensive Main and Sub-Committees (6:30)

**Meeting held and reports given. At the next meeting the Committees will have a list of members that need to be replaced for non-participation. The next survey has been postponed several weeks to allow the sub-committees to finalize questions.**

- Meet with Gene Coffin concerning Brewers Pond (7:30)

**Tabled until next meeting.**

- Meet with Code Enforcement Officer on various issues

**Meeting held. (1) Eric Taylor has applied to the Board of Appeals and DEP is sending a letter to the Town concerning their inspection of the property. (2) Mr. Solvenson has not applied to the Board of Appeals or complied with the requirement to bring the "round house" into compliance - CEO to send a letter. (3) Don Koehling has not applied for a Septic permit for his trailer on Devils Highway - CEO to send a letter. (4) DEP visited the Brewer's property to inspect the pond that was created - they will send him a letter concerning the inspection.**

3. Discuss the following issues

- Letter from DMR concerning removal of Overboard Discharges

**Reviewed. According to the letter the overboard discharge at the Parker Head Mill Pond is a secondary consideration to its opening for Shellfish Harvesting. The primary concern is fecal contamination, which may be coming from a natural source. The area must be surveyed and tested to locate the source, then corrective action taken to alleviate the problem. Clerk to contact the Dick Lemont to request testing and survey of the area. Following that, removal of the overboard discharge will be considered.**
