Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. with Selectmen Totman, Wells and Rice present.

1. Review and Sign:

- Meet with Town Landing Committee concerning Meadowbrook Boat Ramp
Meeting held. The ramp has become unusable due to erosion. The Town Landing Committee had an onsite meeting 3 weeks ago with Ted Crooker (contractor who built the ramp three years ago) and Joe Norton (Taylor Engineering – designed ramp.) The fault may lay with the size of the rip-rap as well as the possibility that the required fabric material was not installed. Peter Roberts requested that the Selectmen put an article on the upcoming Town Meeting warrant requiring that they seek legal action against Crooker and Sons. The Selectmen voted not to put the article on the warrant. Selectmen Rice volunteered to meet with Ted Crooker to see if they intend to make repairs. He will bring back a proposal for the next meeting.

- Meet with Purse Line Bait and others concerning Road Postings (8:00)
Meeting held. Road Commissioner reported that the town roads were “borderline” for opening. The Board of Selectmen voted unanimously to remove all the road postings (weight restrictions) effective immediately. The Road Commissioner and Board of Selectmen will meet with Jennie Bichrest prior to next winter to discuss her options for access to her business, Purse Line Bait.
