MINUTES

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. with Selectmen Wells and Rice present

1. Review and Sign:

- Accounts payable and payroll warrants
- Minutes

3. Discuss the following issues

- Comp Plan copies

Clerk to make copies of questionnaire results for each Sub Committee Chair.

- Appointments to the Road Committee

We received five requests for appointments to the five vacant positions on the Road Committee. The Board of Selectmen voted to appoint Ed Skillin, Richard Palmer, Clifford Newell, Robert Butler, and Leslie Smith to the Committee. They will also add an alternate position, which Richard Murphy will fill.

- Transfer Station “contractor debris.”

Selectmen decided that debris from boat construction is not prohibited for disposal under the contractor clause of the Transfer Station Ordinance.

- Delinquent Tax Payers/Tuesday meeting

Selectmen Wells will attend.

- Letter to DOT concerning “toll booth”

Selectmen reviewed and approved the letter as drafted by Selectman Rice. Copies will be sent to Governor King and the Town of Lebanon.

- County letter concerning fiscal year tax impact/bond

Clerk to send a letter to the County asking that the bond period be two or three years vs. five years. There is a concern that the County may have to go out to bond for a correctional facility in three years.

- Delivery of CEO letter

Selectmen authorized that a letter from the CEO to Mr. Bowker (concerning Don Koehling’s lack of septic system) be served by the Sheriff’s Dept. since Mr. Bowker he has not picked up his certified copy.

- DOT contract for rebuild of second section of Popham Road

Selectmen will review contract and vote on it at the next meeting.

4. Review the following items

- Shellfish Warden Report

Reviewed. No action taken.

5. Discuss attendance at the following meetings, courses, and seminars

- Land Use Law Update
- Tedford Shelter annual meeting

No one will attend. Clerk to send copies of Land Use law Update information to Comp Plan Chairs, Planning Board, Board of Appeals and CEO.

6. Miscellaneous

- **Clerk to contact Merle Chaney to see if he will put a locked cover on top of the old tank at the landfill. This will be used for disposal of dead animals.**
- **Clerk to contact the Town of Westport to get a copy of the letter they sent to the NRC concerning Maine Yankee Power Plant.**
- **Selectmen voted to expend \$1,000.00 for the purchase of a portable loudspeaker system. This will be cost shared with the School and possibly the Recreation Commission.**
- **Clerk to contact Ashpludh to remove dead limbs from several large trees on Old Ferry Road that could cause damage to vehicles. Clerk will also advise abutting property owners of this action.**
- **Selectman Rice will chair the Comprehensive Plan Town-wide meeting on October 25th.**
