MINUTES

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. with Selectmen Wells, Rice and Douglass present

Meeting held. Ms. Zimmerman gave a status update on the "Winnegance Wheelers" Club. They currently have 37 members and are growing. The Club wants to make sections of Town roads "Shared Use." Selectmen recommended that the Club continue to work with private landowners to build their trail system. Selectmen have asked the Club to make an exact list of roads and sections that they would like to have as "shared use". Issue tabled until this information is provided.

- DMR response letter on Water testing

Selectmen reviewed response and did not consider it in the best interest of the Town. They voted to ask Representative Etnier to continue his efforts to introduce a legislative bill to correct the situation. Clerk to draft a letter to David Etnier requesting this action, with copies going to the Town's of Woolwich, Boothbay Harbor, Harpswell and West Bath.

- Meet with Planning Board and Board of Appeals to discuss Ordinances

Meeting held and ordinance changes concerning private road setbacks and abutter notification were discussed. Planning Board and Board of Appeals will submit recommendations.
