- **Betty Totman provided information concerning the possible change in traffic pattern in Bath due to construction of the Hannaford Food Store. - **Selectmen will dedicate the Town Report to those serving in the armed forces.**
- **T/A will get health insurance quotes for town employees who work 10 Hours minimum, 20 hours minimum and 35 hours minimum.**
- **The Chief of Police presented a letter to the Selectmen from Norman Turner, the Animal Control Officer. Norm is resigning his position as ACO on July 1, 2003. The Chief of Police will contact other ACO's in the area and see if they would like to "regionalize" the position.**
