MINUTES

June 15, 2005

*Called to order at 8:50 p.m. with Selectmen Rice, Douglass and Perkins present.  
Meeting was late due to a new business hearing.*

1. Review and Sign:

- Accounts payable and payroll warrants.
  - ID Card for Parking Enforcement Officer & Chief of Police
- All items reviewed and signed.**

2. Meetings and Hearings:

- Meet with the new Parking Enforcement Officer  
**Victoria Jones is the new Parking Enforcement Officer. She arrived at 7:00 p.m. but had to leave prior to the start of the meeting.**

- Meet with the Chief of Police, John Skroski, to discuss the resignation letter from the part-time Patrol Officer, Jeremy Deweese.

**The Selectmen reviewed a resignation letter from Patrolman Deweese effective June 25<sup>th</sup>. Selectmen voted (3-0) to accept the resignation.**

**The T/A reported that GAC had paid their posted roads fine of \$250.00. Purse Line Bait is scheduled to meet with the Selectmen in July to discuss their fine.**

**Chief Skroski mentioned that the State DOT will be opening a review of the Parker Head/Route 209 intersection. He was directed to notify the Public Safety Committee and abutting property owners.**

- Meet with the Assessing Agent concerning Flaherty Abatement (corrective)  
**Selectmen voted (3-0) to grant the abatement due to a clerical error.**
