- **Selectmen voted (3-0) to approve an appropriation of \$4,754.00 from the School Capital Reserve Account for the purchase and installation of 2 steel entry doors (with panic exit devices and closers) for the School.**

- **It was reported that all administrative appeals brought before the Board of Appeals on July 19th were denied (Marco, Gallagher and Gensheimer.)**

- **Curtis Doughty, Road Commissioner, stated that there were 5 or 6 trees by Meadowbrook Campground that were in poor shape could fall into the electrical wires or onto the road. One is close to a homeowners property line. He had an estimate of \$600.00 to remove the trees. Selectmen authorized the tree removal for \$600.00 and requested that Mr. Doughty discuss the removal of the one close to the property line with the homeowner. Selectmen also requested that he remove two trees in poor shape at the Transfer Station.**

- **Selectmen approved the installation of a "Children Playing" sign on Meadowbrook Road as well as corner arrows. The T/A will check with State DOT to see if they also have to approve the corner arrows.**
