

# Phippsburg Transfer Station Information

## Permits

- Permanent Permit Stickers are available at the Town Office or Transfer Station and are to be attached to the lower left hand corner of the vehicle windshield. Temporary and Cottage permits are only available at the Town Office.
- Only the Cottage Permit may be transferred from vehicle to vehicle. If you sell your vehicle please remove the Permanent Permit Sticker.

## Miscellaneous Information

- The Transfer Station is located at 58 Sam Day Hill Road.
- Only residents and taxpayers of the Town of Phippsburg can use the Transfer Station.
- All items and trash brought to the Transfer Station must originate in Phippsburg.
- Only building debris generated by the homeowner as a self-help project can be brought to the Transfer Station (contractor debris must be taken out of Town.)
- For more information please refer to the 1996 Solid Waste Ordinance available at the Transfer Station or Town Office. If you have any questions please call Martha or Russ at the Transfer Station (389-1402) or Mike at the Town Office (389-2653).

## Transfer Station Hours

**Winter Hours** (starting Sep 15th) - Wed 8-4, Sat, 8-4

**Spring Hours** (starting May 1st) - **Mon 10-6**, Wed 8-4, Sat 8-4

**Summer Hours** (starting Jun 15th) - Mon 10-6, Wed 8-4, **Fri 8-4**, Sat 8-4

**Notes:** Due to weather conditions during the winter the Transfer Station may be closed and reopened the next day. If so, it will be advertised on local television and radio stations. The Transfer Station will be closed for observed holidays and open the next day.

## **\* PLASTIC CONTAINERS (Emptied, Rinsed and Caps Removed)**

(ACCEPTABLE)

Plastic Containers Stamped H.D.P.E. #2  
(i.e. milk, Juice, Water Bottles, Detergent  
& Bleach Bottles, etc.)

(NOT ACCEPTABLE)

Plastic Containers that have contained  
Motor Oil, materials classified as  
Hazardous Waste.

## **\*CLEAR GLASS (Emptied, Rinsed and Caps Removed)**

(ACCEPTABLE)

Soda Bottles  
Juice Containers  
Food Containers

(NOT ACCEPTABLE)

Ceramic Cups/Plates  
Colored Glass & Drinking Glasses  
Mirrors/Windows

## **\*NEWSPAPERS & MAGAZINES**

(ACCEPTABLE)

Newspapers, Magazines & Phone Books

(NOT ACCEPTABLE)

Hard Cover Books & Paper Bags

## **\*ALUMINUM & TIN CANS (Emptied and Rinsed)**

(ACCEPTABLE)

Food Cans

(NOT ACCEPTABLE)

Cans that have contained Motor Oil,  
materials classified as Hazardous Waste  
and Aerosol Cans

**\* - Also can be put in Recycling Containers at the Town Hall Parking Lot**

## **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD (Flatten All Cardboard)**

(ACCEPTABLE)

Corrugated Boxes  
Brown Paper Bags  
Printed Corrugated Containers

(NOT ACCEPTABLE)

Waxed Boxes  
Food Contaminated Cardboard  
Paperboard (i.e. Cereal Boxes, Shoe  
Boxes)

## **UNIVERSALWASTE ACCEPTED**

Florescent Bulbs  
PCB Ballasts  
Nicad Batteries & Mercury Products

Televisions and Monitors  
Computers

## **OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING**

Propane Tanks (20# - BBQ Size)  
Tires  
Metal (Refrigerators must have doors  
removed and tanks must have end  
removed)

Homeowner Generated Building Debris  
Clean Brush and Wood  
Items for the "Swap Shop"

Note: Uncontaminated Motor Oil, Uncontaminated Antifreeze and Whole Car Batteries can be taken to Pine Tree Service Center. Asbestos can be taken to the Bath Landfill (call them ahead to make arrangements). Hazardous Waste cannot be accepted at the Transfer Station – it should be kept until the "Annual Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Day" in July.
